5. Background Information

- 1. Council has funding for the provision of 11 CCTV systems on major Council facilities on Bathurst and Melville Islands.**
- 2. The CCTV systems should be utilize Digital Video Recording, motion detection, email alerts, infrared or similar night time recording, with possible video uploaded to a central cloud storage. Connections can be either wired or wireless, linking to existing Council internet connections on site.**
