PURPOSE:

This policy illustrates the guidelines for Tiwi Islands Regional Council (TIRC) Pool and Sports and Recreation employees.

OBJECTIVES:

The objective of this policy is to ensure that the Council works collaboratively with schools where pools or water features exist, to implement a “Go School, Go Pool” attitude.

POLICY:

Children currently enrolled in the Tiwi Islands School must attend each school day, as indicated on the Department of Education website and on the day of the child attended, he/she shall be permitted free entry to the pool or water feature.

The parents or carers of children who have attended a full day of school, and who attend with their child(ren) to supervise their swimming, will receive free entry.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

School – Before the end of the school day, supply daily attendance sheet to the TIRC pool officers on duty at the pool.

TIRC – Records the school students from the list who attend, and supply the lists to the Regional Manager of Sports and Recreation at the end of the week.

RECONCILIATION:

At the beginning of every fifth week of school term, the Principal and the Manager of Sports and Recreation meet to discuss attendance rates.
