## **PURPOSE:**

This policy illustrates the guidelines for Tiwi Islands Regional Council (TIRC) Sports and Recreation employees.

## **OBJECTIVES:**

The objective of this policy is to ensure that the TIRC works collaboratively with schools where pools or water features exist, to implement a “Go School, Go Pool” attitude.

## **POLICY:**

Children currently enrolled in the Tiwi Islands schools must attend each school day, as indicated on the Department of Education website<sup>i</sup> and on the day the child attended, he/she shall be permitted entry to the school or water feature.

The parents or carers of children who have attended a full day of school, and who attend with their child(ren) to supervise their swimming, will receive free entry.

## **RESPONSIBILITIES:**

**Schools** – The school will issue a ticket to each child that they deem has presented at school and met the acceptable standards of school behaviour.

**TIRC** – Record the number of school students presenting with a school ticket, and supply the numbers to the Regional Coordinator Sports & Recreation at the end of each week.

## **RECONCILIATION:**

At the beginning of every fifth week of school term, the Principals and Regional Coordinator Sports & Recreation meet to discuss attendance rates.
