In relation to your letter dated 27 November 2013 requesting a variation to utilise the \$19 000 unspent funds from the 2012-13 Active Remote Communities funding agreement.

The Department of Sport, Recreation and Racing approve your request to use the money to support the Tiwi Islands women's AFL 9 a side competition (Healthy Lifestyle Cup), send both a men's and women's team to Darwin for the NT Softball Championships August 2014 and funding support for Sport and Recreation Officers to undertake a sports medicine course (attachment A).

The acquittal timeframe will be extended to 30th September 2014. However, if expenditure of the approved grant amount occurs prior to this date acquittal of the grant at your earliest convenience would be greatly appreciated.
